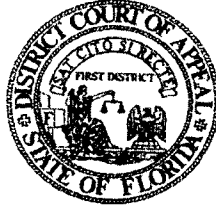


NOTICE
Attorneys and Registered eDCA Users

September 30, 2011

In order to conserve scarce court resources, the following court notices will no longer be mailed in paper format to attorneys and registered eDCA users when a new case is opened. These notices are to be accessed electronically via the court's website (www.1dca.org). **These notices provide important information and requirements with which all filers are expected and required to comply.**

- Notice to Attorneys and Parties (revised January 6, 2011) – All Cases
Provides useful information regarding filing with the court.
- Notice Re: Electronic Filing of ALL Pleadings Through eDCA (Revised August 2, 2010) – All Cases
Provides information on the court's requirement that all pleadings filed by attorneys and registered users be filed electronically through the court's online portal, eDCA.
- Notice of Electronic Filing of Docketing Statements (Revised March 31, 2010) – All Cases
Provides information on the court's requirement that docketing statements filed by attorneys and registered users be filed electronically through the court's online portal, eDCA.
- Notice in Workers Compensation Cases – Workers' Compensation Cases
Provides information regarding the court's policy on motions for extension of time in workers' compensation cases.

Attorneys and registered eDCA users are to access electronic versions of these court notices on the court's website under the "FAQ/Frequently Requested Information" link. When completing the online docketing statement through eDCA, attorneys and registered users will be required to certify that they have read and are familiar with the court's notices. Unregistered non-attorneys will continue to receive paper notices by mail.
