

The clerical error that resulted in the first order of April 21, 2008 being erroneously issued in Allstate Floridian Insurance Company, et al. v. Office of Insurance Regulation, 1D08-275 was that the order was released prior to the ten business days provided in the court's internal operating procedures section 6.1 for considering en banc proceedings when a motion for rehearing en banc is filed. The motion for rehearing en banc was filed April 14, 2008 and thus the earliest permissible release date for the decision on the en banc motion would have been the 11th business day after the filing of the motion for rehearing en banc which would be Tuesday, April 29, 2008. The order was withdrawn in order to give the entire court its full time authorized by court rules to consider the motion for rehearing en banc that was prematurely cut off by the erroneously issued order. A new order disposing of the issues will be released at a later time after full compliance with court rules.
